TICINO PARK AND THE AGRICULTURAL LANDSCAPE

Morimondo and the "Irrigated Meadows", the Geraci Park Visitors Center, the Bereguardo boat bridge, Vigevano and its treasures

Built starting from 1136, the Morimondo Abbey, in addition to the religious and architectural aspects of particular value, is nestled on the summit of a rural territory of considerable beauty descending towards the river banks where some irrigated meadows, typical feature of the Lombary agricultural landscape, have survived (meadows flooded also of winter, where we find the mixing of cultivation, artwork and historical-cultural witness to make it an element of great importance to preserve and admire, also for its faunal-environmental value). This is an evidence of the important human work that took place over time and the history of the landscape system of irrigation waters and of evergreen meadows. That constitute an historical testimony of a landscape widely diffused in the past in the Milan plain, and now limited to the Ticino Valley enough to be a candidate for the National Register of Historic Rural Landscapes. The visit will be carried out by a naturalist guide of the ticino park and by an expert in historical landscape who will describe the historical-environmental peculiarities of this territory.

The considerable interest in the architectural part of the Morimondo Abbey (Romanesque style of the round arches is combined with the Gothic elements of the pointed arches and with the cross vaults) is therefore combined with the skilful care of the territory and with the recovery of traditional practices and old crafts that helped to design the landscape of the Ticino Valley.

The visit will continue at the farmhouse "Cascina Caremma", a fine example of Lombard dairy farm, where you can enjoy a light lunch on site with branded products. Then guided tour at the Visitor Center Geraci, area located in the Municipality of Motta Visconti, where you can view the redevelopment works carried out as part of a LIFE Project (LIFE "Ticino Biosource") for the reconstitution of wet and forest environments (where previously there were extensive cultivations of poplars) within the source area of the Ticino Valley by naturalist professionals. We will then proceed with a visit to the boat bridge of Bereguardo (one of the last examples of barge bridge in Italy, wanted by the Visconti in 1374 for the connection between the two banks of the Ticino it was replaced by the Sforza with a stable bridge), a visit to the historic centre of Vigevano (Piazza Ducale and Castello Visconteo Sforzesco), an ancient art city and a Renaissance pearl that inspired Leonardo, and the closing aperitif.
