Writing your paper and sharing your data. An insider's guide to publishing.

Course presentation

After a brief 'insider's' introduction to the day-to-day world of publishing, the first part of this course will cover aspects of preparing manuscripts for peer review and publication. We'll discuss topics including publication types, preprints and pre-submission review, journal scope and publication criteria, copyright and licensing, authorship, cover letters, and data and materials sharing. We will also discuss the importance of reproducibility and how to apply reporting guidelines.

In the second part of the course, we'll look at the peer review process from the perspective of both the author and reviewer, and discuss how to respond to reviewers' comments when revising your manuscript.

Finally, we will talk about the dissemination of your research- how to use a range of channels to reach the widest audiences, engage with the media, and maximise the impact of your work.
